

COMPETITION

The Organising Committee will offer the following disciplines in men's and women's event:

- 1. Road event
 - -Road Race
 - -Individual time trial
 - -Criterium
- 2. Mountain bike
 - -Cross Country (XCO)
 - -Eliminator (XCE)


Each country may enter:

- for road race events, a maximum of six men and six women, and
- for mountain bike events, a maximum of six men and six women.

The delegation may include the officials, according to the number of competitors entered:

- -Up to nine participants: three officials,
- -Up to twenty participants: four officials,
- -Over twenty participants: five officials.

At the first General Technical Meeting, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative shall confirm and sign the official list of competitors accredited by CIC. Every cyclist must have a national cycling license that is valid for the year of the Championship and issued by his/her national federation, which shall be affiliated to UCI.





TRAVEL

The countries shall be responsible for their own cost of travel to Aeropuerto Internacional Juan Santamaría (SJO). This is located 2,5h from San Carlos. This is the official point of entry of the Championship.

ACCOMMODATION

The first official hotel for the FISU Cycling Championship is the Hotel Termales del Bosque (https://termalesdelbosquecr.com/).

The property belonged to Don Esteban Ramírez since 1886, the date of the first deed, a resident of the city of Naranjo and great-grandfather of the current owners, who are the Arroyo Bolaños family.

In 1996, it was decided to exploit the thermal water sources for tourism, which spring to the surface after having filtered into the slopes of the Platanar volcano and which are heated by underground lava veins to temperatures of 50 C. These sources have mineral content and they are recognized for their therapeutic properties.

The hotel rooms are strategically located, all 45 rooms distributed in 5 sections have views of the gardens. There are rooms for single, double, triple and quadruple occupancy.

We also have 3 fully equipped Villas with kitchen, living room, two bedrooms with TV, air conditioning, wifi, private bathroom and hot water. Each villa with capacity for 7 people.

Guests can stay connected with free in-room WiFi.
