

COMPETITION

The Organising Committee will offer the following disciplines in men's and women's event:

- 1. Road event
 - -Road Race
 - -Individual time trial
 - -Criterium
- 2. Mountain bike
 - -Cross Country (XCO)
 - -Eliminator (XCE)

Each country may enter:

- for road race events, a maximum of six men and six women, and
- for mountain bike events, a maximum of six men and six women.

The delegation may include the officials, according to the number of competitors entered:

- -Up to nine participants: three officials,
- -Up to twenty participants: four officials,
- -Over twenty participants: five officials.

At the first General Technical Meeting, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative shall confirm and sign the official list of competitors accredited by CIC. Every cyclist must have a national cycling license that is valid for the year of the Championship and issued by his/her national federation, which shall be affiliated to UCI.








The organisers can change the program or cancel competitions if the conditions call for such a change. Conditions include extreme weather and matters of public health and safety.

Competition rules

Anti-doping

The FISU anti-doping rules apply to the 2024 FISU Championship Cycling. The UCI anti-doping rules apply to the races.

Transparency

Family members and club mates of participating Costa Rican athletes as well as nonparticipating athletes of the Costa Rican national team may be involved in the organisation of the 2024 FISU Championship Cycling. We appreciate that this can pose a threat to the fair play the sport relies on. However, Cycling is a sport rooting in respect and without the involvement of these people, we could not offer competitions of the highest quality. Extra care will be taken to make sure all is managed openly and with full transparency
